

Prescription Monitoring Program – NL

Monitored Drug List

Last updated: October 2018

Monitored drugs are defined in the regulations of Prescription Monitoring Program - NL as opioids listed in **schedule 1 of the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada)** <u>AND</u> **tramadol**.

The following is a list of commonly used drugs that are captured by this definition.

Note: This is not an exhaustive list as new drugs, or newly-marketed brands of drugs, can become available at any time. If the medication being prescribed contains an opioid, it is subject to the requirements in the **Prescription Monitoring Act**.
